Prospective interns will be required to come for a final on-site interview so that he or she can see the facility and make an informed decision regarding acceptance, if/when internship is offered. Applicants will be notified in writing regarding the status of their application following the on-site interview. Following approval, a legal affiliation will need to be documented with MUSC Health. Music Therapy intern candidates must be enrolled in an American Music Therapy Association (AMTA) approved undergraduate Music Therapy Program.

Please include a resume with application packet that notes your work, volunteer and clinical practicum experiences. Be sure to include location, dates, and responsibilities.

Letters of Recommendation

Please submit three letters of recommendation:

- 1. The Director of Music Therapy as a recommendation and eligibility for internship
- 2. A clinical supervisor
- 3. A person of your choice, excluding family member or work supervisor

Transcript

Please submit your transcript (official or unofficial) of all university/college academic coursework.

Expectations of MUSC Music Therapy Interns

- 1. All applicants should have the desire to work in a large inpatient and outpatient medical setting, with varied populations.
- 2. Applicants must have excellent musical skills with main instrument, and functional skills with guitar and piano.
- 3. Applicants must complete all course work as specified by college or university.
- 4. Applicants must be prepared to complete assignments and special projects as outlined in the MUSC internship packet.

- 5. Accepted applicants must participate in all orientation requirements. The accepted applicant is responsible for obtaining background checks, two-step PPD, and any required vaccinations prior to start date.
- 6. Applicants are responsible to provide ongoing education about the Arts in Healing Program to MUSC Health leaders, physicians, care team members, and the community.
- 7. Applicants are expected to document and maintain records, progress reports, and statistical information in appropriate formats while also fulfilling the Arts in Healing Program and facility-wide quality assurance/performance improvement standards.
- 8. Applicants are required to participate in weekly on-site supervision to ensure best practice and continuum of patient care.
- 9. A legal affiliation is required between the intern's university and MUSC. The Legal Affiliation Agreement must be in place <u>before</u> an intern can begin internship.
