**Key:**

- ACUTE = Acute primary care based in emergency medicine and common minor surgical procedures
- ADD = Addiction Medicine
- BHVL= Behavioral Health = includes psychiatry, hospice and palliative medicine
- ELEC/IL = Elective/ Individualized Learning
- HO= Hematology-Oncology
- ICU= Intensive Care Unit
- METO= Metabolic (Endocrinology, Bariatrics, Podiatry, Vascular Surgery, Urology, and Wound Care)
- MSK= Musculoskeletal (Rheumatology, Sports Medicine and Physiatry)
- NEURO- GI = Neurology and Gastroenterology (2 weeks/ each)
- OP GIM= Outpatient General Internal Medicine Clinic
- PULM= Pulmonology
- T (1/2/3) = General Inpatient Ward Teams (each team has educational focus and admits patients with related diagnosis)

**Clarifying notes:**

- Our Schedule is built on Thirteen (13) Four (4)-week block rotations (Monday to Sunday);
- Outpatient General Internal Medicine Clinic includes longitudinal curriculum and learning activities in: Social Determinants of Health, Population Health, Quality Improvement, and Research/ Scholarly Activity;
- Continuity Clinic is ½ (one-half) day per week with the exception of ICU rotations; residents will be assigned to site 1/2/3 based on individual preference and availability.
- Pulmonology- the pulmonology rotation Includes Sleep Medicine
- Inpatient Teams:
  - T1- General Internal Medicine with special focus on Cardiology and Gastroenterology
  - T2- General Internal Medicine with special focus on Infectious Disease and Pulmonology
  - T3- General Internal Medicine with special focus on Nephrology, Hematology-Oncology and Geriatrics
- Vacation may be taken in 1 or 2 week increments during elective rotations
- Elective selection will be done with faculty advisor to augment their Individualized Learning Plan
