

We have an experienced care team that includes members from varied disciplines such as nephrology, gastroenterology, cardiology, and rheumatology. We strive to provide evidence-based care, while incorporating the latest advances in diagnostics and treatments, including clinical trials.

Pulmonary hypertension is a complex health problem that is characterized by high blood pressure within the lungs, which can lead to heart failure. Frequently, patients with pulmonary hypertension are not recognized until they have advanced disease because early symptoms can be confused with those of many other conditions. An earlier diagnosis, a greater understanding of the disease, and the development of a comprehensive treatment plan can improve quality of life and prognosis in this life-threatening condition.

Pulmonary vascular diseases (PVD) are a group of conditions that affect blood circulation in the lungs, making the heart work harder. These conditions, including pulmonary hypertension, can lead to cardiovascular problems as well as impair quality of life.

The Pulmonary Vascular Disease program at MUSC Health offers a multidisciplinary health care team, advanced treatment options, clinical trials, patient education, and support groups for patients with these conditions.

# We treat many pulmonary vascular diseases, including:

- Pulmonary Arterial Hypertension
- COPD or ILD Pulmonary Hypertension
- Chronic Thromboembolic Pulmonary Hypertension
- Hereditary Hemorrhagic Telangiectasia
- Hepatopulmonary syndrome
- Pulmonary arteriovenous malformations

Our team of providers offer state-of-the-art care in the diagnosis and treatment of pulmonary vascular diseases. They work closely with our colleagues in cardiology, rheumatology, nephrology and other specialties to ensure our patients receive comprehensive and supportive care, tailored to their individual needs.
